Prelim Exam - Additional Information

- The exam diet will run from Monday 4 December to Tuesday 19 December inclusive.
- Within this period, students sitting National 5, Higher and Advanced Higher level are granted exam leave of one day before an exam with the exception of exams on a Monday due to the weekend.
- Students sitting more than one exam per day are not entitled to multiple exam leave days. The day before the exam(s) is entitled to be taken as exam leave.
- Pupils should carefully note the start time of their exams and ensure they arrive at the location of the exam 10-15 minutes early with all required equipment. Note that the timing of exams do not always follow the school day. Some exams may run over break, lunch or finish beyond the end of a typical school day. Pupils must plan accordingly.
- Location of exams will be posted on the Exam Information Board (opposite the School Office) before each exam.
- Pupils who benefit from Assessment Arrangements will meet with Support for Learning staff to obtain additional information (rooming, exam times etc) ahead of the examinations.
- Students are not required to go to class before or after their prelim exam finishes for that day. However, should a pupil wish to attend classes, they will be made welcome.
- Student attendance will be coded in SEEMiS accordingly. Students will be coded as present during times when they are in school sitting exams.
- Students sitting National 2,3,4 or Wider Achievement qualifications do not require exam leave as there are no external examinations. They will continue to follow their normal timetable.
- Normal classes will resume on Monday 18 December. At this point practical assessments take place in Art & Design and Practical Cake Craft. Pupils with an exam (or exams) on or after this date will not be permitted exam leave on the day prior and should attend classes unless in an exam.
